MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Hunter D. and Skye L. appeals from a judgment terminating her parental rights to the children entered in the District Court (Portland, *Goranites, J.*). Contrary to the mother's contentions, sufficient evidence exists in the record on which the court could find, by clear and convincing evidence, at least one ground of parental unfitness, and that termination of parental rights is in the children's best interests. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2008); *In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶¶ 15, 20, 802 A.2d 976, 980, 981. More specifically, the record supports the court's finding of a link between the mother's inadequacies and the effect of those inadequacies on the children. *See Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 15, 802 A.2d at 980; *cf. In re Jazmine L.*, 2004 ME 125, ¶¶ 21-22, 861 A.2d 1277, 1282.
