MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Culver A. Barr II appeals from the judgment of the District Court (West Bath, *Field, J.*) granting a protection from harassment order, 5 M.R.S. § 4655 (2008), in favor of John Mellecker against Barr. Although Barr contends that the evidence is insufficient to support the trial court's judgment and that in fact the judgment is against the great weight of the evidence, because Barr has not provided a transcript of the proceedings or a statement in lieu of a transcript pursuant to M.R. App. P. 5(d), *see Cates v. Donahue*, 2007 ME 38, ¶ 2, 916 A.2d 941, 942, we must infer that the evidence before the court, while it may have been contested, was sufficient to support the court's findings and conclusions based on those findings, *see State v. Hughes*, 2004 ME 141, ¶ 7, 863 A.2d 266, 269. To the extent that Barr raises other issues on appeal, we do not address them. *See Mehlhorn v. Derby*, 2006 ME 110, ¶ 11, 905 A.2d 290, 293 ("An issue that is barely mentioned in a brief is in the same category as an issue not mentioned at all.").
