MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Steven A. Davis appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Jabar, J.*) awarding the four plaintiffs a total sum of \$27,417 on their complaint for unjust enrichment. Steven Davis contends that the court improperly evaluated the evidence in reaching its findings and conclusions and that the court did not give Steven Davis and his attorney adequate time to present evidence and argument. Review of the record indicates that the court allowed Steven Davis and his attorney to present their evidence and that the court did not prematurely terminate Steven Davis's counsel's arguments as he alleges. Even when evidence is contested, on appeal we must review the record and inferences that may be drawn from evidence in the record in the light most favorable to the trial court's judgment to determine if its findings are supported by competent evidence. *Pratt v. Spaulding*, 2003 ME 56, ¶ 10, 822 A.2d 1183, 1186. Here the evidence, although contested, supports the trial court's findings of unjust enrichment and the amount of damages awarded.
