## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother and the father of Zachariah and Tiras K. appeal from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, Beaudoin, J.) terminating their parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055 (2009). Contrary to the parents' contentions, the court rationally could have found clear and convincing evidence to support the necessary factual findings that: (1) both parents are unwilling or unable to protect their children from jeopardy and these circumstances are unlikely to change within a time reasonably calculated to meet the children's needs; (2) both parents are unwilling or unable to take responsibility for the children within a time reasonably calculated to meet the children's needs; (3) both parents have failed to make a good faith effort to rehabilitate and reunify with the children; and (4) termination of the rights of both parents is in the best interest of the children. See 22 M.R.S § $4055(1)(\mathrm{B})(2)$; In re Cody T., 2009 ME 95, $\mathbb{1}$ 2, 979 A.2d 81, 82. In addition, the court adequately linked parental unfitness with the consequent harm to the children. See In re Jazmine L., 2004 ME 125, © 15, 861 A.2d 1277, 1281.
