MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Chad E. Saunders appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Cuddy, J.*) convicting him, following a jury trial, of criminal use of explosives (Class C), 17-A M.R.S. § 1001(1)(D) (2009); domestic violence terrorizing (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 210-B(1)(A) (2009); and possession of a machine gun (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 1051(1) (2009). On appeal, Saunders contends that the evidence was insufficient to support each of the convictions. Review of the record demonstrates that the evidence fully supports the jury's findings on each charge, recognizing it was for the jury, and not this Court on appeal, to decide questions of credibility and weight and significance to be given to the evidence presented to it. *See State v. Milliken*, 2010 ME 1, ¶ 17 n.5, 985 A.2d 1152, 1158.
