MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jennifer B. Johnson appeals from the parental rights and responsibilities judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Moskowitz, J.*) awarding her primary physical residence of the parties' child, but allowing visitation with Kent O. Brown on alternate weekends from Friday at 5:00 p.m. to Sunday at 7:00 p.m. Johnson contends on appeal that the visitation period should be shorter. Her arguments are based, in part, on agreements and scheduling conflicts she alleges have occurred since the trial court's judgment and do not demonstrate any abuse of discretion in the trial court's award of visitation rights. *See Smith v. Rideout*, 2010 ME 69, ¶ 13, --- A.2d ---, ---. To the extent that the arguments in Johnson's brief address events that have allegedly occurred since the trial court's order, those arguments are more appropriately addressed in a motion to amend directed to the trial court rather than an appeal directed to this Court. *See Beane v. Me. Ins. Guar. Ass'n*, 2005 ME 104, ¶¶ 9-11, 880 A.2d 284, 286-87.
