MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Christopher Nelson Bilynsky appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Sagadahoc County, *Delahanty, J.*) denying, without an evidentiary hearing, his motion for a new trial, following his conviction, upon a conditional plea of nolo contendere, for criminal conspiracy (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 151(1)(B) (2009). Contrary to Bilynsky's contentions, the court did not clearly err or abuse its discretion in denying the motion. *See Estate of Fournier*, 2009 ME 17, ¶ 11, 966 A.2d 885, 888-89. We do not address his remaining contentions because they either lack merit or were addressed in his prior appeals. *See State v. Bilynsky*, 2009 ME 121, --- A.2d ---; *State v. Bilynsky*, 2008 ME 33, 942 A.2d 1234; *State v. Bilynsky*, 2007 ME 107, 932 A.2d 1169.
