MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor, Gunther, J.) terminating his parental rights to Jack M. pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055 (2009). Contrary to the father's contentions, sufficient evidence exists in the record on which the court could find, by clear and convincing evidence, at least one ground of parental unfitness, and that termination of the father's parental rights was in Jack's best interest. See 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2); In re Marcus S., 2007 ME 24, ¶ 6, 916 A.2d 225, 227. Additionally, because the mother has not filed a notice of appeal, we decline to address the father's challenge to the court's judgment terminating the mother's parental rights. See In re Melissa T., 2002 ME 31, ¶ 5, 791 A.2d 98, 99-100.
