#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Pursuant to 15 M.R.S. § 2115 (2009), Lynn K. Martin appeals from a judgment of conviction of unlawful trafficking in scheduled drugs (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 1103(1-A)(A) (2009), entered in the Superior Court (Aroostook County, *Hunter, J.*). Contrary to her contentions, the evidence was sufficient to support her conviction, *State v. Milliken*, 2010 ME 1, ¶ 19, 985 A.2d 1152, 1158; 17-A M.R.S. §§ 1101(17)(C), 1102(1)(A), 1103(1-A)(A) (2009), and the court did not commit obvious error in declining to grant her a new trial *sua sponte*, as there were no improper statements made during the State's closing argument, *see* M.R. Crim. P. 52(b); *State v. Schmidt*, 2008 ME 151, ¶¶ 15, 18, 957 A.2d 80, 85, 86; *State v. Clark*, 2008 ME 136, ¶ 12, 954 A.2d 1066, 1070.
