MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Maria Cecilia H. Slavin appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Warren, J.*) dismissing her complaint alleging verbal mistreatment by employees of the Department of Health and Human Services. Contrary to Slavin's contentions, the court did not err in dismissing Slavin's complaint, as amended by a subsequent statement of the action, for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. *See Doyle v. Dep't of Human Servs.*, 2003 ME 61, ¶¶ 14-18, 824 A.2d 48, 53-55 (civil rights claim); *Champagne v. Mid-Maine Med. Ctr.*, 1998 ME 87, ¶ 16, 711 A.2d 842, 847 (intentional infliction of emotion distress claim).
